EQUESTRIAN

Premises Registration; As from 1 May 2012, any premises (which includes shows, fairs and markets) where horses or other equines are gathered must be registered with the Department. Owners/persons in charge of such gatherings are required to submit a completed application form for registration and to keep records of movements on/off their premises. Records must be retained for at least 3 years as they may be required by the

Department for the purposes of tracing disease. Records required are:- The name and address of the owner/person in charge of the premises from which the equine came and premises registration number from which the equine came and Passport number/ UEL number of the animal.

It is important therefore that Show organisers should contact their local District Veterinary Office in advance so that consideration can be given to compliance with the requirements outlined above. Class 29: Champion Cob or Pony

Champion Class - no direct entry.

Class 1: Riding Ponies, 14.2 hands & under - to be shown under saddle

Class 2: Lead Rein Competition for Ponies 12.2 hands & under, lead by an adult & ridden by a child 7 years & under

Class 3: Lead Rein Competition for Ponies 14.2 hands & under, lead by an adult & ridden by child 8-12 years old

Winner will receive the Teresa Helen Memorial Perpetual Shield

Class 4: Ponies - 12.2 hands & under

Description: to be shown in hand

Class 5: Ponies - 13.2 hands & under

Description: to be shown in hand

Class 6: Best Mare or Gelding not exceeding 14.2 hands

Winner will receive The Kildee Perpetual Cup.

Class 7: Best Registered Connemara Filly or Gelding.

Description: Sponsored by AXA Insurance, Cavan

Winner will receive Secretary's Perpetual Cup.

Class 8: Best Registered Connemara Colt or Filly Foal

Any IPS members entering this class will not be allowed to compete.

Class 9: Best Connemara Brood Mare, stunted or with foal at foot

Class 10: Open Miniature for Horses, Under 34", 3 Years & Under

The Champion Ridden Pony is not eligible to compete in Led Championship

The O'Donoghue Atlanta Perpetual Cup will be presented to the Champion Ridden Pony

Class 11: Open Miniature for Horses, Under 34";, 4 Years and Upwards

Class 12: Shetland Pony - Best Filly, Mare or Gelding to be shown in hand

Class 13: Best Entry for Style & Appearance

Class 14: Best Donkey, Male or Female, to be shown in hand

HORSES

Entry Fee: €10 unless otherwise stated.

Class 30: Champion of Horse Section

Champion Class - no direct entry.

Class 16: Best Brood Mare, Stinted or with Foal at Foot, Heavy-Weight Hunter

Class 17: Best Non-Thoroughbred Brood Mare, Stinted or with Foal at Foot, Light-Weight Hunter

Class 18: Best Colt Foal (open)

Class 19: Best Filly Foal (open)

Class 21: Premium for Mares with Foal at Foot, to be judged as a pair

Description: Four premiums will be awarded to the value of €70, provided they are entered in Classes 16 & 17 as appropriate.

Class 22: Best Yearling Colt/Filly Non-Thoroughbred

Class 23: Best 2 Year Old Colt/Filly, Non-Thoroughbred
